The Bernese Mountain Dog Club of the Rockies has planned these trials and shows scheduled for October 8, 9 and 10, 2021, in accordance with public health requirement in place as of the publication of the premium list. The health and welfare of our exhibitors, judges, club members and all those who work to make the shows a success is paramount.

At the time of publication of the premium list, no COVID-19 public health requirements were in effect for the show site and the size of our events. Any change to requirements will be included with the Judging Program and posted on our website (BMDCR.org) and will be based on the Arapahoe County and Colorado State requirements and the AKC Suggested Best Practices for the Well-Being of Dog Sport Participants (available at AKC.org).

In the event of a change in public health requirements necessitating cancellation, any entries submitted will be refunded. Grooming and RV fees will also be refunded.

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is a highly contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death.
